Contest rules:

Eligibility

The contest is open to all fourth Grade students in the Rapid City Area School and Douglas District service areas. All entries should be submitted on an individual basis. No shared work is allowed.

Entry Limit

Only one poster per student.

Entry Deadline

Entries will be collected from the student's teachers by Friday, September 15th. They will then be picked up by a Black Hills Area Habitat for Humanity employee and displayed in ReStore starting Monday, September 18th. Alternately, students can submit their entry directly by turning them in to the staff at the ReStore registers in Rapid City.

Objective

Design a poster demonstrating the theme: Building a Strong Home in my Community.

Poster Size and Description

Poster can be horizontal or vertical, measuring 8.5" x 11". Full name and school must be written on the back of the poster.

Media

Any mixed media suitable for reproduction as a poster is allowed. Posters must be two-dimensional. All posters must be original art. No trademarked or copyrighted images or phrases should be used.

Winners

One first, second, and third place winner will be chosen by whoever has the highest number of votes in ReStore. Customers will be encouraged to choose their favorite posters by putting a piece of paper with the poster number on it in the ballot box in ReStore. Only one vote per customer, please. Winners will be announced Friday, October 6th.
